Students of our Loyola Academy matriculation school participated in Zonal competition conducted at padappai

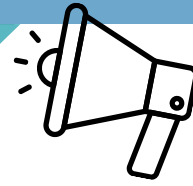

Our students achieved outstanding success in the chess tournament held at Kundrathur Boys High School and made us proud with their impressive performances.



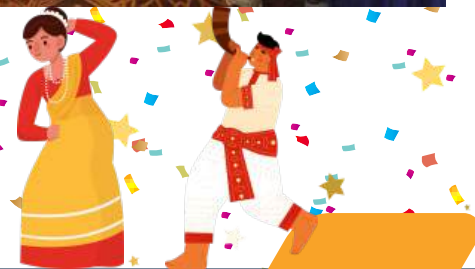
LAMS @ YMCA

The meeting provided an opportunity for parents and teachers to interact, discuss student progress, and address the concerns.

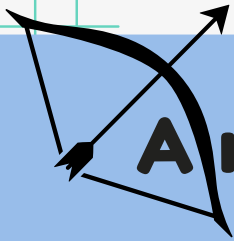
