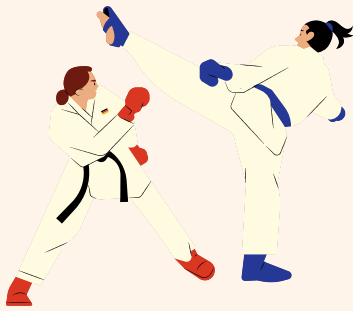


CODING CLASS

A coding class, also known as a computer programming class, is an educational setting where students learn to write code and develop programming skills.



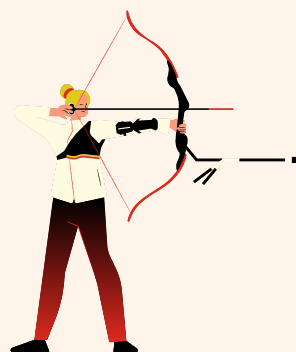
